# Called to Ecumenism

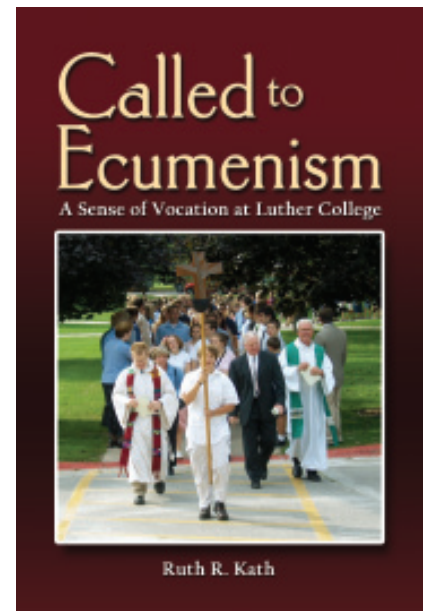
## A Sense of Vocation at Luther College

The author chronicles the longstanding call to ecumenism that has characterized Luther College. The way the Luther College community welcomes its neighbors to join the conversation about faith and learning is foundational to Dr. Kath's telling of the story. Important to the telling of the Luther story are the voices of ecumenists who have helped to shape the vision of inclusion for the campus and for the town of Decorah. The voices from the Luther archives, faculty, students, and others provide reflections on the special ecumenical calling of this small liberal arts college of the church.

Ruth R. Kath, Director of *Sense of Vocation* Program at Luther College, has extensively researched the college's call to ecumenism, the special sense of vocation that Luther College has experienced. Kath tells the story of the extraordinary ecumenical call of Luther College through the voices of the people who have shaped its ecumenical life over the past forty years.
